ELIGIBILITY

Students participating in the Hayward 4 Learning voluntary program must be four years of age by **September 1st**. There will be no early admissions. Participants must be residents of the Hayward Community School District. For more information, contact Northwest Connection Family Resources at 634-2299.

HAYWARD 4 LEARNING REGISTRATION

Northwest Connection Family Resources will schedule appointments with parents who would like to register their children for the four year old program. Northwest Connection Family Resources is located at 16076W Highway 63, Hayward. Registration appointment times can be scheduled any time after April 1st between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.,

Monday – Friday. We encourage all potential 4K learners to be registered prior to August 1st in order to reserve a spot in the program. Registration packets will be sent to you when the appointment is made.

Materials to bring with you for the registration appointment include:

- A birth certificate for the child/children being registered
- Verification of physical address: a utility bill, bank statement, or phone bill with your correct and current address
- Immunization records for the child being registered
- Current medical physical examination documentation
- Your child's social security number
- Registration forms
