Safety & Respect Driving School is currently accepting Driver Education registrations for students in the Hayward School District for the 2020 calendar year.

Course Options Include:

Online Classroom and Behind-the-Wheel (\$350)

This package is for the student under age 18 who chooses to fulfill the state required driver education classroom hours online in the comfort of their home. It includes:

- 30 hour state approved Online Driver Education instruction
- 12 hours of Behind the Wheel instruction (6 driving hours and 6 observation hours) with our state certified instructors

Blended Classroom and Behind-the-Wheel (\$375)

This package is a mix of both the **online and traditional classroom**. It includes the following:

- 30 hour state approved Online Driver Education instruction
- One three-hour traditional classroom session that includes:
 - o 90 minutes of critical content from the traditional driver education class
 - o 30 minutes of Instruction Permit Preparation
 - o One hour administration of Instruction Permit exam (Instruction Permit test must be passed to earn a WI DMV issued permit to drive)
- 12 hours of Behind-the-Wheel instruction (6 driving hours and 6 observation hours) with our state certified instructors

Both the Online and Blended Classroom sessions fulfill the state required 30 classroom hours. Per Safety & Respect guidelines, students will have 6 months to complete the Online/Blended course. Students may take the Online/Blended classroom portion of Driver Education as early as 14 and 7 months of age. We recommend taking the Online/Blended classroom portion between the age of 15 and 15.6 years of age.

Instruction Permit: Once a student is 15.6, he/she may begin the Behind the Wheel portion of Driver Education provided the student has completed or is currently completing the online classroom portion of Driver Education, has passed the written Instruction Permit exam, has a valid Instruction Permit from the DMV, and tuition is paid in full. Tuition must be paid in full to receive the signed MV3001 form. Behind the Wheel times are posted on the Safety and Respect website. Students must log in to their student portal with their username/password to secure their driving appointments.

The user-friendly website will walk you through the enrollment and payment process. Or if you need more information email: info@safetyandrespect.com. All students must print out the Contract for Services located under the Resources tab of our website. Both the parent/legal guardian and student will need to sign the contract to give us permission to provide Driver Education to your teen. The contract must be returned (by mail or electronically) to Safety and Respect prior to receiving access to the online class.

Safety and Respect Driving School is a private commercial driving school. All students enrolled in the program must follow the guidelines established by the State of Wisconsin for commercial driving schools.
